Conditions of Entry

All players must be an affiliated member of a South Canterbury Club and available to be selected for a South Canterbury representative team. That is, not playing for another Association.

VENUE: Trust Aoraki Tennis Centre, Benvenue Ave, Timaru.

TENNIS NZ CODE OF CONDUCT: This tournament will be subject to the New Zealand Tennis Code of Conduct. A copy is available at the venue. All competitors must be correctly dressed in approved tennis attire whilst on the courts. Only tennis shoes with non-marking soles to be worn.

SCORING & GAME LENGTH

It is intended to run games as follows:

Best of 3 sets

The Tournament Director reserves the right to shorten the length of matches if necessary. The intention is for every player to have a minimum of two singles matches, but this will be dependent on entries and weather. The Tournament Director also reserves the right to shift venues and use lights if necessary. Maximum warm up time will be 5 minutes.

UMPIRING: Players are required to umpire their own matches and may be asked to adjudicate matches as required.

Any disputes, problems or queries are to be referred to the Tournament Referee whose decision will be final.
